Engaged students, learning

We will continue to create intentional future focused strategies that foster student engagement and personalised learning ensuring every learner thrives in our dynamic and inclusive environment. We will

- Implement whole staff approach for NCCD data collection and processes for supporting identified students, supporting teachers with strategies for the students' needs to save time and maximise use of resources
- Implement a whole school approach to Mathematics to enhance the rigour of planning, teaching and assessment, including teacher training and upskilling in numeracy teaching and assessing.
- Develop a whole school plan for curriculum implementation and assessment, reflecting multiage class structures.
- Create learning dispositions which facilitate students' understandings of St Finbarr's culture and their role in the learning process - ability to identify what makes a good learner, how learning occurs and how to seek support.
- Collaboratively develop a whole school approach to student behaviour and engagement in learning.

Being distinctively Catholic

We will nurture the Catholic faith, learning and community by embedding Gospel values into every aspect of school life guiding students to grow spiritually academically and socially in a Christ centred environment. We will

- Enhance religion curriculum programs and complement this with the implementation of these values within all key learning areas across the school
- Educate the wider community and parents on the values and importance of our faith and provide opportunities for development and understanding.
- Communicate and implement core values that are utilised daily in classroom routines and provide students and staff with the skills to transfer this on a personal level within the wider community.

Using resources wisely

We will focus on using resources wisely ensuring that every decision reflects stewardship, sustainability and equity – maximizing impact for student learning and community wellbeing. We will

- Collaborate with all stakeholders to finalise and publish a Master Plan inclusive of modern, adaptable furnishings and ensure school is accessible for all community members.
- Create and Implement a Marketing plan
- Regularly review and update eLearning Plans
- Regularly review and update Reading resources to stay current with advancements.
