# **Characteristics of the student body**

St Finbarr's School is a co-educational school for Prep to Year 6 students. The School had 29 students enrolled in 2023, with 12 being male and 17 being female.

Within the student population, 24% identified as Indigenous and 0% had a language background other than English.

The School's Index of Community Socio-Educational Advantage (ICSEA) score was 947 (Australian average is 1000), with 12% being in the top quartile, 23% in bottom quartile and 31% and 34% being in the middle two quartiles.

#### Description of how non-attendance of students is managed by the school

Members of the Quilpie community are disadvantaged due to distance. Non-attendance of students can be the result of instances such as flooding, siblings in boarding school, doctors' appointments several hours away or daily distance travelling.

A genuine effort is made by parents and staff to ensure that students have work to complete when they will be absent for extended periods of time.

St Finbarr's completes its roll electronically and this is done in the morning and after lunch. Hard copies of rolls are also kept in classrooms for teacher reference, fire drill and lockdown procedures.

If students are absent from school, parents are required to notify the school **via email**. In cases where the student is unexpectedly absent and information from parents has not been forthcoming, the parents are

phoned, asked to explain the absence and give an indication of when they anticipate the child will be returning to school and an email is to be sent to the school explaining the absence.

Prolonged absences from school without explanations result in a phone call/meeting with the principal to discuss the situation.
